Baseball games are at Livingston Field, Altgeld Park (Harrison & Washtenaw) or Touhy-Herbert (Adams & Hoyne) and go May 16 to Aug. 1. Girls softball goes May 2 to July 18 and includes Sheridan Park (Polk & May) and Skinner Park (Adams & Loomis). T-ball at Livingston Field until August 15. Boys 13-15 may play night games at 8pm at Altgeld Park. Practice times will be set by the team coach. T-Ball, Boys 8-10, & Girls 8-11 include coach pitch.
