3. Girls Softball ages 8-11 (Sat. 10am at nearby parks)
4. Boys Baseball ages 10-12 (Wed. 6pm & Sat. 11 at Altgeld)
5. Girls Softball ages 11-14 (pre-h.s.) (Tue. 6pm & Sat. 1pm)
6. Boys Baseball ages 13-15 (evenings & Sat. afternoons)

Baseball games are at Livingston Field, Altgeld Park (Harrison & Washtenaw) or Touhy-Herbert (Adams & Hoyne) and go June 4 to Aug. 6. Girls softball games go May 7 to late July and includes Skinner Park (Adams & Loomis) and Harrison Park (Damen & 18th). T-ball at Liv. Field goes June 4 to Aug. 27. Boys 13-15 may play night games at 8pm at Altgeld Park. Practice times will be set by the team coach. T-Ball & Girls 8-11 include coach pitch and safety balls.
